1. Introduction

Children's Interest Continuum™ ("CIC," "we," "us," or "our") uses cookies and similar technologies to support the operation, security, and functionality of the CIC Platform and associated websites.

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, how CIC uses them, and how users may manage cookie preferences.

This Policy supplements the CIC Privacy Policy and Terms and Conditions.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files stored on a user's device when visiting a website or using an application.

Cookies may help websites and applications:

- remember preferences;
- maintain secure sessions;
- improve functionality;
- understand usage patterns;
- improve reliability.

Similar technologies may include:

- local storage;
 - session storage;
 - authentication tokens;
 - similar browser-based technologies.
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3. How CIC Uses Cookies

CIC may use cookies and similar technologies for the following purposes:

Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for Platform operation.

They may support:

- user authentication;
- secure sessions;
- account access;
- security protections;
- maintaining user preferences.

Users may not be able to use certain Platform functions if essential cookies are disabled.

Security and Authentication Cookies

These technologies help:

- verify user identity;
- maintain authenticated sessions;
- protect accounts;
- prevent unauthorized access.

Functionality Cookies

These may support:

- remembering user preferences;
- maintaining application settings;
- improving user experience.

Analytics and Performance Cookies

Where used, these technologies may help CIC understand:

- Platform performance;
- feature usage;
- errors;
- reliability.

Information collected through analytics is used to improve Platform functionality.

4. Cookies and Sensitive Case Information

CIC does not use cookies to publicly track, advertise, or disclose user case information.

Cookies and similar technologies are not intended to store:

- evidence;
- case documents;
- litigation records;
- financial records;
- uploaded materials.

Case Content is maintained through secured Platform storage and access controls.

5. Third-Party Services

CIC may use trusted third-party service providers that utilize cookies or similar technologies to support Platform operations.

Examples may include services related to:

- authentication;
- infrastructure;
- communications;
- analytics;
- security.

Third-party providers operate according to their own privacy practices.

6. Managing Cookies

Users may manage cookie settings through their browser settings.

Options may include:

- disabling cookies;
- deleting stored cookies;
- controlling website permissions.

Disabling essential cookies may affect Platform functionality.
